I have a passion for telling stories within the Hispanic community, and have dedicated my career to doing just that. I want to keep being an advocate for my community in any way possible.

I moved in January from Atlanta, where I was heavily involved in different organizations tailoring Hispanic people, including: the National Association of Hispanic Journalists, Hispanic Young Professionals and Entrepreneurs, and was selected as one of Georgia's 50 Most Influential Latinos. I also produced, edited, and hosted two 30-minute specials during Hispanic Heritage Month, highlighting the important work we do for our communities. I want to keep doing that hard work in Tampa, and being in the board of THHI would be an honor.

When I first moved to Tampa, one of the groups most of my coworkers and family had mentioned to me, was THHI. They know my passion for elevating the Hispanic community, and encouraged me to learn more about this wonderful non-profit. Organizations like THHI are crucial to helping keep our culture alive: our language, traditions, food, events, music, etc. THHI recognizes that Hispanic heritage should be celebrated all year - not just during Hispanic Heritage Month.
